Directions to Orchard Side B&B and The Annex

Approaching from the North:

Exit **M5** at Junction 7- Follow the signs (A449) to **Malvern**. You will cross over the river and at the next roundabout turn left to Malvern. Keep left taking the road signposted to **Upton and Callow End (B4424)** – After several miles take the next right turn signposted - **Great Malvern (B4211)**. Turn immediately left signposted **Hanley Swan**. Pass the Camp Site, and the church on your right and Orchard Side Bed & Breakfast is on the **LEFT** after a few houses.

(If you reach the cross road, duck pond, and the pub you have gone too far!!)

Approaching from the South:

Exit the **M5** at Junction **8** onto the **M50**. Exit M50 at Junction 1 and follow the **A38 to Malvern**. After a few miles turn left onto the **A4104 to Upton**. After crossing the river turn right onto the **A4424** signposted to **Malvern**. At **Hanley Castle** turn left onto the **B4209** signposted to **Hanley Swan** & brown sign to Three Counties Show Ground. Turn **RIGHT** at the village cross road signposted to Worcester - The Swan Pub will be on your right and the Duck Pond on your left. This is the **Worcester Road** and Orchard Side Bed & Breakfast is about 9 houses down on the right hand side.

(If you see the church on your left you've gone too far!)



There are 2 sets of electric gates and generally one set will be open (if closed come through the pedestrian gate and knock on the front door)

If you are staying in the Annex, park directly in front of the Annex front door (To the right of the double garage)

If you are staying at the B&B please park in the front of the house. If there is a car parked please just park behind it.
